If you've been a member for at least one year, you are eligible to rent the clubhouse exclusively for \$350 per event through a completed application and written RYC Board approval. Since we allow just one weekend night rental per month during the boating season the dates fill up fast, so if you're thinking about securing the clubhouse for your event the time to reserve is now as dates are filling up for 2023.

### **Safety Officer** Brian Roberts


