Trash containers on the patio and in clubhouse continue to be abused by members detracting from the patio and attracting flies. The containers are not provided for your boating trash. There are there to support casual patio use. There are two dumpsters located in the parking lot where you park your vehicle. Please use them. Our cleaning service is only at the Clubhouse each Friday so overloaded containers may remain for several days. If this continues, we will minimize the number of containers.

The docks could also use a little more care. There is trash left in and around the ice machine. Dock boxes with missing lids must be removed; contact the Dock captain if you wish to replace them with a new box. Several boats have torn covers and are infested with spiders. A reminder that you are required to maintain your slip free of spider infestation as a courtesy to your neighboring members. Also, you must keep your boat in good repair. Please review the moorage rules; the standing rules are available on the Club website in the members area.
