Fill out a completed application, you need orientation training (one hour) and written approval required. There are currently rentals that are approved for April 6<sup>th</sup> (boaters education is April 13<sup>th</sup>) April 20, May 4<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup>, and Nov 23<sup>rd</sup> of 2024. We have been fixing water leaks on the docks. All the Docks water has been restored. If you suspect a leak, the main valve is under the diamond plate cover at the top of the ramp leading to D dock. A shout out to Chris Jensen for identifying the leak. Do not open the valve at the far end of A dock. It is for winterization only I will put a label on it. Here is a picture of the main shut off valve to the docks.

To access the Dock Main Water Shutoff valve;

Flip the metal plate cover at top of ramp onto Dock D. And then shutoff the valve that is circled in the photo. Photo shows valve in the ON position, blue handle is in line/parallel with pipe.
