Following that, or if it's a non-life-threatening situation, please inform our Dock Captain, Ed Caraway, as soon as safely possible. Having this process clear helps us provide support and coordinate assistance effectively. Looking ahead, we're excited for the upcoming holiday season. We wish you and your families a very Merry Christmas and a Happy New Year filled with joy and safe voyages.
